**AGENDA: 6: Approval of the Guideline for General Nursing-Midwifery (3- Yrs.) Examination
As per Indian Nursing Council Syllabus**

The Registrar placed the matter to the Members regarding formation of Examination Rule for 3-Years' Candidates as per Indian Nursing Council where mentioned the REVISED SYLLABUS 2015 GUIDELINES for the GENERAL NURSING-MIDWIFERY EXAMINATION.

The authorities of all Govt./Non-Government Institutions conducting GENERAL NURSING-MIDWIFERY (3-Years) COURSE under West Bengal Nursing Council are hereby being informed regarding the below specified Norms of the Supplementary Examination as directed by the INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL. All Supplementary Examinations will be conducted by this Council within 06(Six) months after the completion of the Annual Examination.

FIRST YEAR EXAMINATION

(Practical related Papers means Nursing Foundation & Fundamentals of Ng.)

- A] i) If a candidate fails in either TWO Theory Papers OR Practical related One Paper, she/he may be allowed to Continue the Classes of Second Year (i.e. she/he have to appear in Two Papers only).
ii) She/he may be allowed to appear for Supplementary Examination in the failed subject/s after 06(Six) Months.
iii) She/he will appear for Second General Nursing-Midwifery Examination as usual after Six Months' after completion of the failed Paper/s of First Year.
- B] If a Candidate fails in MORE THAN TWO Theory Papers OR/With Practical related One Paper (i.e. she/he have to appear in more than Two Papers), she/he will not be allowed to attend the Classes of Second Year. She/he will appear for his/her failed subject's examination after 06(Six) Months and if she/he passes in the failed subjects then only she/he will be allowed to attend the Second Year Classes and appear in the Second Year Examination after One Academic Year from the Date of Passing the last examination.

SECOND YEAR EXAMINATION

- C] i) If a candidate fails in ONE Practical Related Paper (i.e. she/he have to appear for both Theory Paper & Practical only), she/he will be allowed to attend the Classes of Third Year.
ii) She/he may be allowed to appear for Supplementary Examination in the failed subject after 06(Six) Months.
iv) After passing the Failed Subject, she/he may be allow to continue for the Third Year Classes and will appear for Third Year Examination as usual after Six Months.
- D] If a Candidate fails in MORE THAN ONE Theory Papers OR/With Practical related Paper (i.e. she/he have to appear in more than Two Papers), she/he will not be allowed to attend the Classes of Third Year. She/he will appear for his/her failed subject/s examination after 06(Six) Months and if she/he passes in the failed subjects then only she/he will be allowed to attend the Third Year Classes and appear in the Third Year Examination after One Academic Year from the Date of Passing the last examination.

THIRD YEAR EXAMINATION

- E] If a candidate fails in ONE OR MORE Subjects (i.e. she/he have to appear for both Theory Paper & Practical for Practical Related Subject/s), she/he may be allowed to appear for Supplementary Examination in the Failed Subject after 06(Six) Months'. After Passing/Clear all the Paper/s, including the Internship papers of the Third Year Examination then only Council will declare a qualified student/s.

NO CANDIDATE WILL APPEAR UNTIL SHE/HE SHOULD PASS THE PREVIOUS YEAR FAILED SUBJECT/S EXAMINATION

NOTE

- 1] A Candidate will get MAXIMUM PERIOD 06(Six) YEARS TO COMPLETE THE COURSE as per INC Guideline and the Decision resolved by the Education & Examination Committee Meeting of the State Nursing Council held on 24th November, 2016.
- 2] If a Candidate fails in either Theory or Practical Paper, she/he has to RE-APPEAR for both the Theory & Practical Papers.
- 3] A Candidate must secure 50% marks in Internal Assessment separately in each Theory & Practical. (Subject wise).
- 4] Institute shall submit average Internal marks for students of each year not exceeding 75%.
- 5] All the Institutions should prepare the TRANSCRIPT PER BATCH [INC Ref. F.NO. 1-5/2013-INC, Dated 18/11/2014 (Sl.No.27)] as per the Decision resolved by the Education & Examination Committee on 24/11/2016.
