

## **NOTIFICATION**

It is hereby being notified that on the basis of the order no. HFW/NHM - 916/2017/004, dated: 02/01/2019 from the Director of Health Services, Govt. of West Bengal and No. HFW-27011/279/2018-NHM SEC-Dept. of H & FW/5933, dated: 03/12/2018 from the Programme Officer, NHM & Dy. Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Health & Family Welfare, the office of the West Bengal Nursing Council will henceforth conduct the course of Bridge Programme Certificate on Community Health for Nurses (BPCCHN) under the below enlisted guidelines set by the members in the Meeting held on 02nd April, 2019 regarding BPCCHN course:

- 1) The admission in the course of BPCCHN will be held in the months of January & July in every year. However, for session 2019 - 2020 only, the course duration will be from February to
- 2) The student registration forms will be submitted by the recognized institutions within 01(one) month from the date of submission by the representatives of the concerned training institutions.
- 3) The students will get only 07(seven) days preparatory leave before the final (Council) examination. In case of excess leaves, the candidate has to make up the excess no. of duty days and then the candidate may be allowed to be released from the course.
- 4) The candidates must have minimum 80% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) in the Theory & Practical in each subject for appearing in the examination.
- 5) The standard of passing/gradation of BPCCHN candidates will be followed as per the Indian Nursing Council guidelines.
- 6) The medium of instruction & examination of the said course will be English only.
- 7) In case of re-sit candidates, the re-sit examination will be held after every 06(six) months interval and the candidate may be allowed to get 02(two) attempts along with her main examination.
- 8) After successful completion of the course, the candidate will get 01(one) necessary qualification certificate from the undersigned.
- 9) The remuneration and Team Based Incentive will be paid form West Bengal Nursing Council in accordance with the below enlisted pattern:
  - a) Remuneration of the Programme in Charge will be Rs. 1,000/- per month for 06(six)
  - b) Remuneration of the Counsellor for every 02(two) hours (Theory & Practical) will be Rs.500/.
  - c) Team based incentive for maximum 04(four) staff (including clerk, Gr.D Staff, Sweeper & Driver) will be Rs.2,000/- per month for 06(six) months.
  - d) Remuneration for checking answer scripts & conduction of practical examination will be as per the guideline set by the West Bengal University of Health Sciences (WBUHS i.e. @ Rs.20/- per candidate.
